

AT-HOME ACTIVITIES

Family Activities Candy and Ice Experiment

You will need candy and ice cubes!

1. Ask everyone to eat a piece of candy.
2. Discuss: How does it taste?
3. Ask everyone to put an ice cube in their mouths and leave it in for as long as possible.
4. Immediately after removing the ice, replace it with a piece of candy.
5. Discuss: Now how does the candy taste? (Because the ice has numbed the tongue they should not taste the candy)

Ask: Why did the candy taste different? What caused the change?

When we only think about ourselves, our heart (tongue) is numbed toward others. We are unable to see when they need help, and we can't taste the reward of doing service for others.

Family Discussion Questions:

1. What happened in Jesus' story this week? What did he teach about?
2. Who was the good neighbor in the story?
3. Who is our neighbor?
4. What does it mean to love someone?
5. What are little ways that we can show love to people?
6. Are there any people that are hard for you to show love to? Why?
7. What is one thing we can do this week as a family to show love to people?

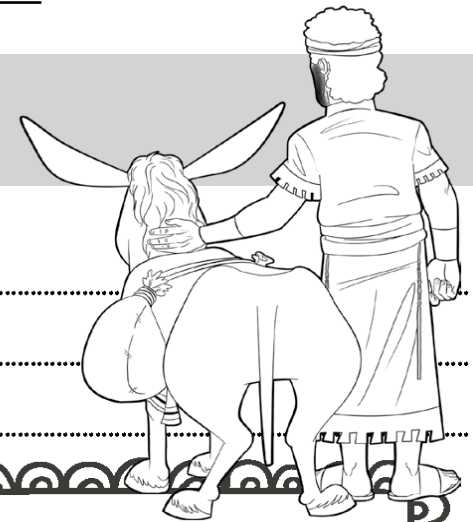
